

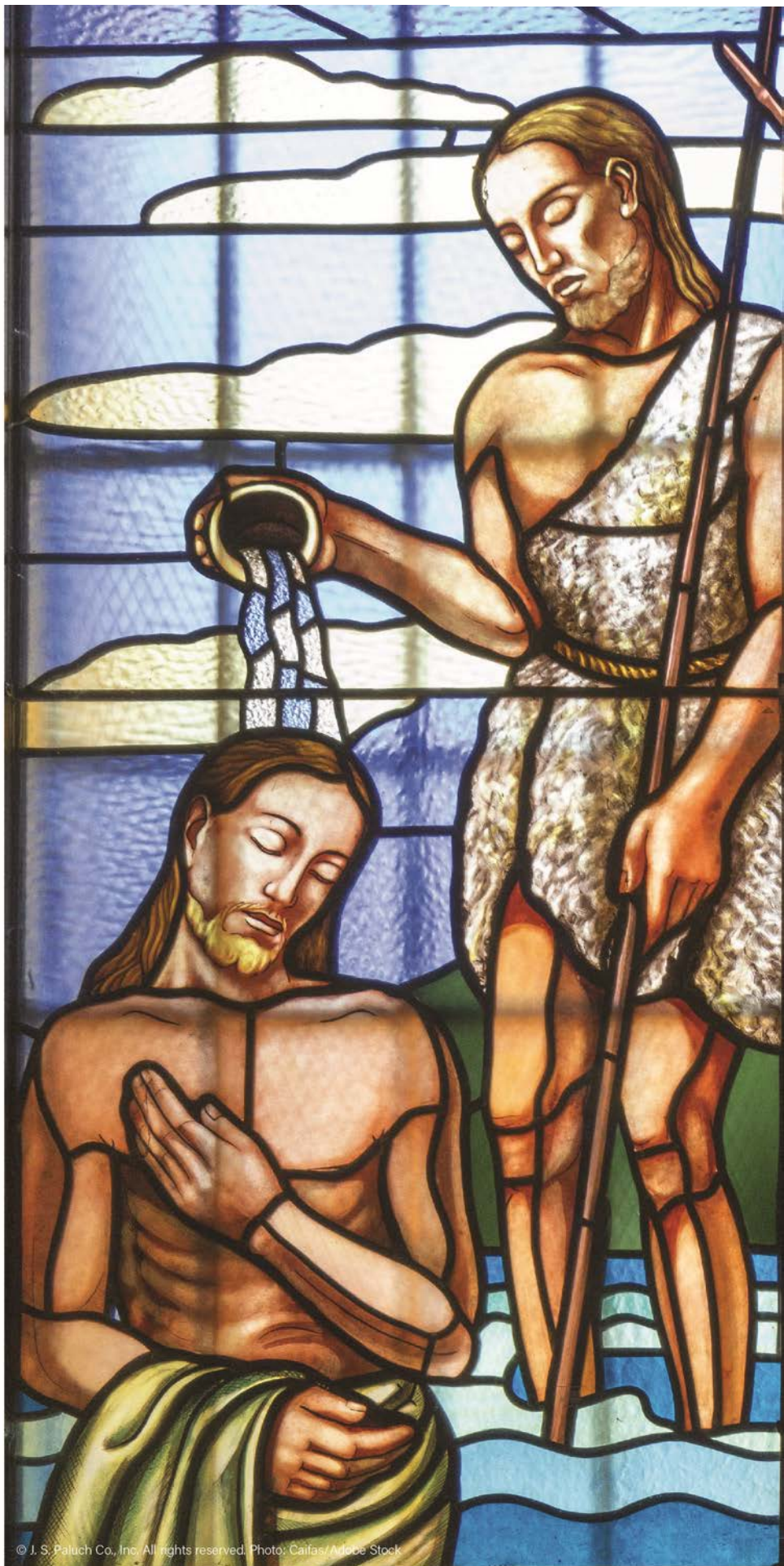

FROM THE PASTOR



From the Pastor:

As we start 2022, there are a few staff changes to announce to you. The first of those is Bob Vaccaro has announced he will be reducing his hours to part-time this spring and then retirement in the fall. Bob has served this parish very well during his many years here. His dedication and

expertise will be missed as an employee here, but his kindness and generous spirit will continue to be present here at the parish, either at Mass on Sunday mornings or volunteering where help is needed. Bob is the reason Spartan Fields has been professionally managed for decades. He is currently exploring options of how it will continue to be maintained professionally and economically in the future.

The second staff change is Matt LeFebvre (maintenance) is ending his employment of five years here at St. Peter to begin his own maintenance business. Doing so has been a dream of his, so we wish him the best in operating his own LLC. We will miss both his kindness and technical expertise here at the parish. Matt's primary responsibility has been the maintenance of the high school and activities buildings, with some cleaning duties added in recent years.

This leads to the third change. Roger Zellner (maintenance) has agreed to become the Facilities Manager for our campus. He is looking forward to the challenges of his new position, and we are looking forward to him applying his skills and dedication to the entire campus. Roger's primary responsibility has been the elementary and Montessori buildings. He will be a "working manager" in that his time will be divided between administration and actual repair work. His many years of experience and attention to detail make him well suited for his new responsibilities.

Since Roger and Matt have been helping to clean our campus school buildings, additional help will be needed. Currently, two cleaning companies are providing part-time contracted employees to clean the school buildings. Going forward we will work with just one of the companies to provide consistent, reliable cleaning of the school buildings. Roger will be their onsite supervisor.

The last staffing change to report to you is that Tricia Oswald has been hired as a theology teacher for grades 7-12. She has teaching experience in Wisconsin, where she attended college, and in Arizona at a Catholic mission school. She has been discerning whether God is calling her to become a religious sister. She lived in religious formation during her college years in Wisconsin. Now she is living here in Mansfield, teaching in our school, as she continues her discernment. Please welcome her when you see her and keep her in your prayers as she seeks God's will.

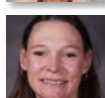

The Baptism of the Lord

who, when Christ had been baptized

JOURNEY TOWARD GOD

As we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord, we also honor our own baptism as our initiation into the Christian life and community. In the Gospel, the baptism of Jesus, with his immersion and then emergence from the water, points to his later submission to God at his death, and his emergence from the grave at his resurrection. This pattern of death and resurrection is our path too, as followers of Jesus. Throughout life, often in small ways, we learn to surrender our limited and self-centered agendas. This surrender often feels like death. The sacrament of Baptism ritually enacts this pattern to remind us of Jesus' death and resurrection, so that we too might embrace the deaths and resurrections of our own lives. As Jesus emerged from the water, he encountered his Father and the Holy Spirit. Like Jesus, we can know we are God's beloved, empowered by the Spirit.
